SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

The Central Coast Paralegal Association ("CCPA") has scholarship funds available for CCPA members, as follows:

Paralegal Studies Certificate or Paralegal AA Degree Program Scholarship

Eligibility:

1. Current member of the CCPA;
2. Currently enrolled in a Central Coast-based Paralegal Studies Certificate Program or Degree Program which meets the requirements of Business & Professions Code section 6450, et seq. or successor provisions;
3. Proof of completion of at least one Paralegal Studies Certificate or Degree Program course; and
4. A grade point average of 3.0 or better.

To apply: Complete the Scholarship Application and attach (1) proof of completion of at least one course and 3.0 GPA, (2) a letter of recommendation from an instructor, and (3) a short essay addressing why you want to become a paralegal and your career goals.

Paralegal Certification Scholarship

Eligibility:

1. Current member of the CCPA;
2. Proof of completion of a course in preparation of taking a certification test; and
3. Proof of having taken a certification test (whether pass or fail).

To apply: Complete the Scholarship Application and attach (1) proof of course completion, (2) proof of certification test completion and (3) a short essay regarding your certification goals.

Restriction: Scholarship awards of up to \$500.00 per member per calendar year are available. Deadlines for scholarship submission are April 1st and October 1st, for award within the next six weeks to qualified applicants.
